Lobby Of County Council Thursday 21 October

Massive cuts to Council services totalling £69 million this year AND £60 million put aside to sack staff. That's not financial expediency its political madness. Happy to sack the staff no matter what the cost, all the name of privatisation.

We are urging all members to join the lobby of the full council meeting on Thursday October $21^{\rm st}$, when Councillors will be discussing the proposals of the Tory administration to make huge cuts, totalling some £69 Million. Over the next 3 years they are proposing to make cuts of £150 million and have already announced redundancies of about 3,000 staff. They are estimating the redundancies will cost some £60M!! Why waste this money on slashing jobs and services!

We are lobbying to express our anger and outrage at these plans, which would decimate the services provided by N.C.C.

They are planning to sell off all the Elderly Persons Homes, Highways/ Roadworks, Country Parks, Supported Employment, Facilities Management, County Supplies, etc. You can be guaranteed this will only be the start, if they get away with this there will be more on the cards, and eventually sell off everything, like Suffolk County council plan to do.

These plans are clearly politically motivated rather than based on any necessity. UNISON has presented cogent alternatives to the Tory's proposals but they don't want to listen, their sole intent is to privatise irrespective, they are intent on their slash and burn policies.

The lobby on the 21st October is our chance to stand together and say we will not sacrifice our public services when it is the bankers who have caused this crisis!
