

NO TO PROPOSED INCREASED CHARGES FOR NOTTINGHAM CITY ADULT SOCIAL CARE SERVICES

We call on Nottingham City Council not to increase charges for adult social care services. Having only just brought in charges for some services the City Council proposes huge increases for services:

- 15% increase for meals from £2.60 to £3.00
- 25% increase in hourly home care charges from £9.20 to £11.50
- 75% increase in day centre charge from £2.00 to £3.50
- 54% increase in transport charge from £2.60 to £4.00
- Scrapping of current maximum home charge of £81 to no upper limit.

Particularly in the current financial climate service users will not be able to afford these increases and will be forced to either reduce or give up using these services altogether. This will then threaten the very existence of these vital public services.
