


# Do you trust the coalition government with your confidential medical records?



Do you think a huge new database of NHS numbers and your personal info, available to private companies, can be kept safely and permanently anonymised?

If you do, ignore this leaflet, but if you don't: we invite you to act now and tell your GP you want to **OPT OUT** of the *care.data* scheme.

Roughly half of GPs recently surveyed are opting out of care.data personally; some are even considering opting out all their patients, which would be against the law.

That's how concerned GPs are.

It's really easy to **OPT OUT** – just tell your GP! If enough people opt out, **care.data** will be unworkable and of little use to private companies.

care.data is a government initiative, made possible by the Health & Social Care Act 2012, the purpose of which is the wholesale privatisation of our National Health Service.

This includes adding the 'Dissent from secondary use of GP patient identifiable data' code (Read v2: 9Nu0 or CVT3: XaZ89) to my record as well as the 'Dissent from disclosure of personal confidential data by Health & Social Care Information Centre' code (Read v2: 9Nu4 or CTV3: XaaVL).

I understand my request will not affect the care I receive and will notify you should I change my mind. Thank you.
